

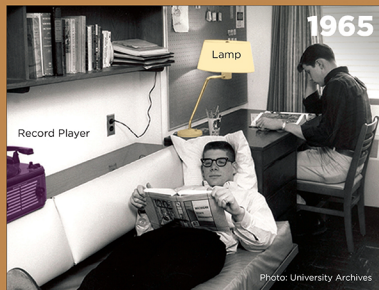

Buy Energy Star

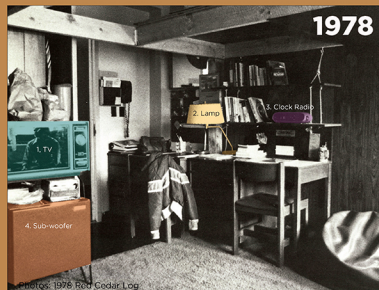

"I pledge to Become Spartan Green by conserving energy and water, reducing landfill waste, and encouraging those around me to do the same during our time at MSU and beyond."

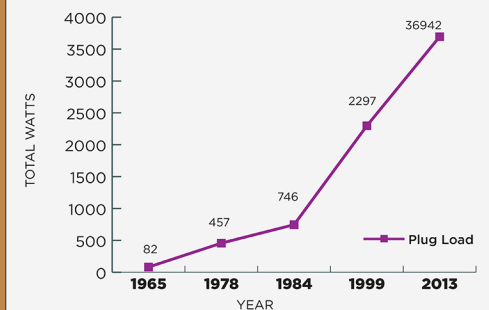

ENERGY SAVINGS TIP
Buy only Underwriters Laboratory approved power strips
Keep away from water
Do not fan or put underneath carpet
Never connect power strips
Make sure power strips have surge protectors and manual shut-offs

Turn off lights when leaving a room for more than five minutes
